<p>Creative Arts</p> 	<p>During the war, clothes and food were rationed and the women had to make their own clothing for their families. This is known as 'Mend and Make Do' (for example mend what they have and create new clothing). Design a poster to advertise making and mending clothes. Look at the examples on our topic wall.</p>	<p>Find an image of a WW2 artefact and draw a detailed pencil picture of it on plain paper (you can get paper from school).</p>	<p>Design and make your own Anderson Shelter (<i>make sure you have completed the research activity for shelters first.</i> If you need materials from school, please come and ask.</p>
	<p>Design your own aircraft. You can choose whether it will be fighting for the Allies or the Axis, and how to make it (drawing, making a model, painting...). Make sure you have completed the research activity for aircraft first.</p>	<p>Design your own board game to entertain your family while you're in the shelter in the Blitz. Make sure you have completed the research activity for entertainment first.</p>	<p>Design a medal to award to the soldiers who won the war on their way home.</p>

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
