### Design and make your favourite book character competition



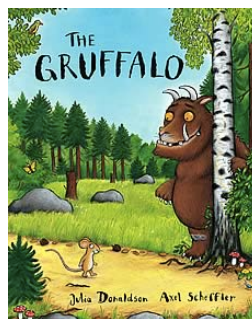
You can choose to create this how you wish, you could make your character out of fruit and vegetables; lego; playdough; craft materials or you may have an idea of your own. Be as creative as you like!
