You will need to keep your notes and work from each session, as you will use these for the final piece of writing later in the unit. You will need to pause the video at the points the teacher asks because you will need to make notes, think or talk to an adult about your ideas. Some of the lessons will ask you to learn specific spellings. As we use *Spelling Frame* for this, you don't have to do these tasks unless you want to do it as an extra challenge.

Please upload your work to Purple Mash as you complete it. We find it more useful if you send your work as you complete it on a daily basis as then we can give you feedback before you start the next lesson.
